

Results Review

- Ryobi reported a net profit of SGD0.9 mln (+67% YoY) for 1QFY13 (Jun.). The results were ahead of our expectations, mainly due to its tax credit of SGD0.6 mln in 1QFY13 derived from enhanced tax deduction under the PIC scheme and lower-than-expected minority interests. These were partially offset by weaker-than-expected gross profit margin of 13.1% (FY13E:13.5%) and higher administration expenses.
- Group revenue increased by 89% YoY to SGD53.7 mln due to higher contribution from bored piling operations (+87% YoY to SGD45.1 mln) as higher value projects were carried out coupled with contribution from its Vietnam and Australia projects. The contribution from its eco-friendly and geo-service operations also increased 102.5% YoY to SGD8.6 mln due to higher value of work done from Marina Coastal Expressway and Downtown Line Stage II Contract 920. Despite the higher revenue, the group reported a 51% decline in pre-tax profits attributable mainly to: (i) weaker gross profit margin (-0.4%-pts YoY to 13.1%); (ii) higher administrative expenses (+48.7% YoY to SGD5.5 mln); and (iii) an exchange loss SGD1.3 mln (vs. gain of SGD0.5 mln in 1QFY12). These were partially offset by an income tax credit of SGD0.6 mln (vs. tax expense of SGD0.14 mln in 1QFY12).
- Ryobi recently secured SGD24 mln worth of contracts, bringing the total contract value secured since the start of calendar year 2012 to over SGD132 mln. These have increased its net order book to SGD90.3 mln as at Sep. 30, 2012.

Earnings Outlook / Estimates Revision

- After fine-tuning our projections, we have kept our FY13 and FY14 net profit forecasts relatively unchanged after incorporating stronger revenue recognition and lower minority interests offset by weaker margins. With rising labor and material costs, the group will continue to improve productivity and be vigilant in costs to preserve its margins.
- Ryobi continues to increase its presence in Vietnam and capitalise on the country's growing demand in the property and construction sectors as the population becomes more affluent and urbanised. With the recent acquisition of the two Australia piling companies, the group is also looking to further expand its presence in the region and capture new opportunities for growth and diversification. Meanwhile, locally the group is poised to benefit from sustained spending in the public sector and HDB's move to boost its new flat supply to 27,000 this year and at least 20,000 in 2013.

Investment Risks

- A sharp rise in labor or material costs, shortage of skilled labor or increase in project execution costs can adversely affect project viability and profitability. Similarly, a slower-than-expected economic recovery and weak property demand is likely to reduce construction demand and erode profit margins due to keener competition. Overseas risk venture for its Vietnam projects such as execution risk, start-up costs and possible delays could give rise to higher operating costs, affecting its earnings.
